The Pot-in-Pot System

Understanding the integral role of spacers in the Pot-in-Pot System

The Pot-in-Pot system is a planting method that provides easy handling and care of trees and large bushes through a specific arrangement of two pots and a spacer. The process starts with embedding a permanent container into the ground. Next, a spacer is added to create a gap between the two containers. A production pot is then placed inside the first container. The spacer simplifies the removal of the production pot from the in-ground container, providing a convenient solution.
